LAURA D'ANDREA TYSON TO DELIVER KEYNOTE ADDRESS AT WOMEN'S PRIVATE EQUITY SUMMIT



Noted economist Laura D'Andrea Tyson will deliver the keynote address at the inaugural Women's Private Equity Summit, to be held March 13-14, 2008 at the Ritz-Carlton Half Moon Bay, California. Dr. Tyson is Professor, Business Administration and Economics at the Haas School of Business, University of California at Berkeley. She was formerly Dean of London Business School from 2002-2006, and Dean of the Haas School of Business, University of California at Berkeley from 1998-2001.

Dr. Tyson served in the Clinton Administration from January 1993 to December 1996. Between March 1995 and December 1996 she served as President Clinton's National Economic Adviser and was the highest-ranking woman in the Clinton White House. Dr. Tyson was a key architect of President Clinton's domestic and international economic policy agenda during his first term in office. Prior to her appointment as National Economic Adviser, Dr. Tyson served as the sixteenth Chairman of the White House Council of Economic Advisers, the first woman to hold that post since the Council's establishment in 1946.

Dr. Tyson has a summa cum laude undergraduate degree from Smith College (1969) and a PhD in economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (1974). She is a member of the Boards of the Brookings Institution, Bruegel, the Peter G. Peterson Institute of International Economics, Eastman Kodak Company, Morgan Stanley Company, AT&T, Inc. and 24/7 Customer.

The Women's Private Equity Summit is designed to enhance networking, fund-raising, and deal-making opportunities for senior-level women in private equity. Panels, roundtables, and social events will focus on building relationships, gaining insight into the changing private equity industry, and sharing deal-making strategies and best practices.
